- The candidate should have 1-2 years of experience providing clinical supervision and experience working with young adults who have endured trauma
- Clinical Social Worker (LCSW, LICSW, LMHC or equivalent)
- Professional experience with crisis management, trauma-informed care, and collaborative and strengths-based approaches
- Valid drivers license and/or reliable transportation for travel as required by the position
